POST IT *to* PROTECT IT

In New Hampshire, common law gives the public access to unposted private land. **Not keen on having hunters roam your property?** It's on you to mark your boundaries with "No Hunting" signs. While this system puts the burden on the landowner, rather than the hunter, it's the unwritten law of the land in this state.

The case against hunting: Hunting inflicts unnecessary suffering, often leaving animals to die slow, painful deaths. It also disrupts natural processes, like migration and hibernation, and destroys animal families. Moreover, it's futile; Leave nature be, and it will self-regulate far more effectively without human meddling.



Post signs on all sides of your property, no further than 100 yards apart, and also at gates and entry points.
